Application for Scholarship Participation**

ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicant must be a student in a course of study leading to a degree or an associate degree or a Certification/License in Construction, Architecture, Landscape, Civil, Mechanical and Electrical Engineering, or other field related to the construction industry.
2. Student must be a resident of Broward County and a U.S. citizen, but may attend the college, university or trade school of their choice, not necessarily in Broward County.
3. Full-time students only are eligible for awards.
4. NAWIC members and their families are not eligible.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant is responsible for insuring that all items listed below are submitted to The Greater Fort Lauderdale Chapter 78 of NAWIC:
 - A. Completed and fully executed application
 - B. Evaluation form completed by your academic advisor
 - C. Official transcript of grades.

AWARDS

1. Scholarship amounts shall be at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee. Scholarships are not automatically renewed, but the student will be considered for subsequent awards if they provide evidence of continued need, continued interest in construction and continued enrollment and good standing in a college program leading to a degree or an associate degree in construction, architecture, landscape, civil, mechanical and electrical engineering, or other field related to the construction industry.

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- 2. Applicants will be reviewed and winners selected by the Scholarship committee of the Greater Fort Lauderdale Chapter #78 of NAWIC, which will consider applicant's interest in construction, grades, extracurricular activities, employment evaluation and financial need.**

- 3. All applicants selected as finalists may be subject to personal interview with representatives of the scholarship committee.**
